

**2006-2007 CSUSB GRADUATE EQUITY FELLOWSHIP**  
**APPLICATION DEADLINE: April 30, 2006.**

California State University, San Bernardino will award Graduate Equity Fellowships to educationally or financially disadvantaged students, including under-represented ethnic minority, women, or disabled graduate students for the 2006-2007 academic year.

The goal of the Graduate Equity Fellowship Program is to assist under-represented students in the completion of the master's degree at CSUSB, and encourage them to pursue a doctorate and teach at the university level. The award is based on academic achievement and the potential for going on to the Ph.D., and eventually teaching at the university level. Fellowships are renewable for an additional year, on a competitive basis. If you are currently receiving financial aid, the Graduate Equity Fellowship may impact your award.

**TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE FELLOWSHIP YOU MUST:**

1. be a member of a group considered under-represented: i.e. African-American, Chicano/Mexican American, other Hispanic, American Indian, Filipino, or Pacific Islander; women in math, science, or computer science, men in nursing, or students with disabilities;
2. be classified as a California resident for fee purposes;
3. demonstrate a minimum financial need as determined by completing the 2006-07 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
4. be admitted to the University and classified or conditionally classified in a master's degree program;
5. be a fulltime graduate student (enroll in at least 8.0 graduate level units, i.e., 500 or 600 level courses);
6. maintain satisfactory academic progress (3.0 GPA);
7. complete all quarterly assignments required by the "Graduate Equity Fellowship Contract". (For a sample contract, contact the Office of Graduate Studies in AD-127).

**TO APPLY:**

1. File the free 2006-07 Federal Application for Student Aid (FAFSA), which is available on the CSUSB Financial Aid Office's web site at <http://finaid.csusb.edu>, **NO LATER THAN APRIL 30, 2006**;
2. Have an application for admission and all required transcripts (including non-CSUSB academic work) on file with the CSUSB Admissions & Student Recruitment Office by April 30th in order to be considered for these awards.
3. Complete the CSUSB Graduate Equity Fellowship Application and personal statement. You may access the application online at: <http://finaid.csusb.edu> or pick up a paper application at the Financial Aid Office.
4. Submit three letters of recommendation from faculty qualified to judge your academic work. Your recommenders must address your specific qualifications as they relate to the objectives of the Graduate Equity Fellowship.

**ESSAY GUIDELINES:** Essays must be typed and double spaced.  
Type your name and student identification number in the upper right-hand corner of each page of your essay.

**LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** Submit three letters of recommendation from persons most familiar with your academic background and abilities. Your recommenders must address your specific qualifications as they relate to the objectives of the Graduate Equity Fellowship.
