### **Research Assistant Position (UNPAID)**

The University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign will be conducting a study at ARMC. We are looking for 3-4 English/Spanish speaking candidates (MPH intern and student physician preferred) interested in **Woman's Health for a prospective study on the Ratings Associated with Diabetes and Depression (RADD) in prenatal mothers.**

The aim of this study is to examine, in a sample of prenatal women diagnosed with diabetes, associations between prenatal depression, self-rated health, self-efficacy and diabetes self-care as well as glucose levels at the time of assessment. Participants will include English- and Spanish-speaking women.

Research assistant would recruit and enroll participants into study, collect and enter data, send de-identified electronic copies of completed surveys, and send hard copies of completed surveys. **MUST BE AVAILABLE DURING CLINIC HOURS: TUESDAY, THURSDAY AND HALF DAY FRIDAY.**
