CSUSB SFS Cyber Corps Scholarship

The CSUSB Cybercorps: Scholarship for Service Program provides funding for up to the last two years of undergraduate or graduate education related to Cyber Security. Students selected for the scholarship are required to work (paid) for the Federal Government in cyber security for up to 2 years upon graduation.

Rehabilitation Services Grant

The Rehabilitation Services Grant provides funding to cover the costs of tuition for students pursuing a Masters in Rehabilitation Counseling. Students are able to payback each year of the tuition support by working two years for a non-profit agency which provides services to individuals with disabilities. Another payback option includes re-paying the Department of Education.
