I. Assessment Activities

The HD faculty have begun implementation of its outcomes assessment plan. Specifically, students in HD 575 are required to produce work samples (appropriate for each student's placement site) that will be included in their respective portfolio. In the spring quarter of 2004, additional data for the assessment program will be gathered in two sections of HD 480 (Advanced Human Development). HD 480 is a required course for all majors.

Please note that the current plan being implemented applies only to Child Development (Track 1), Lifespan, and the Adult Development and Aging tracks of the Human Development major. A plan for Child Development, Track II will be coordinated with the Liberal Studies program pending the approval of modification for major requirement as necessitated by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC). Child Development, Track 11 will no longer be a waiver program.
